Classical Civilisation A Level OCR H408

Purpose of task:

To understand some of the Greek myths that have influenced the texts we will be studying at A Level.

Task:

You should make notes on:

- The War between the Titans and the Olympians
- The Judgement of Paris
- The Trojan War

A lot has been written about these myths, so it is important to select only the key points.

Once you have researched these myths, it is then up to you how you present the information – perhaps on a poster, leaflet, as a comic strip, or simply an A4 page of notes.
